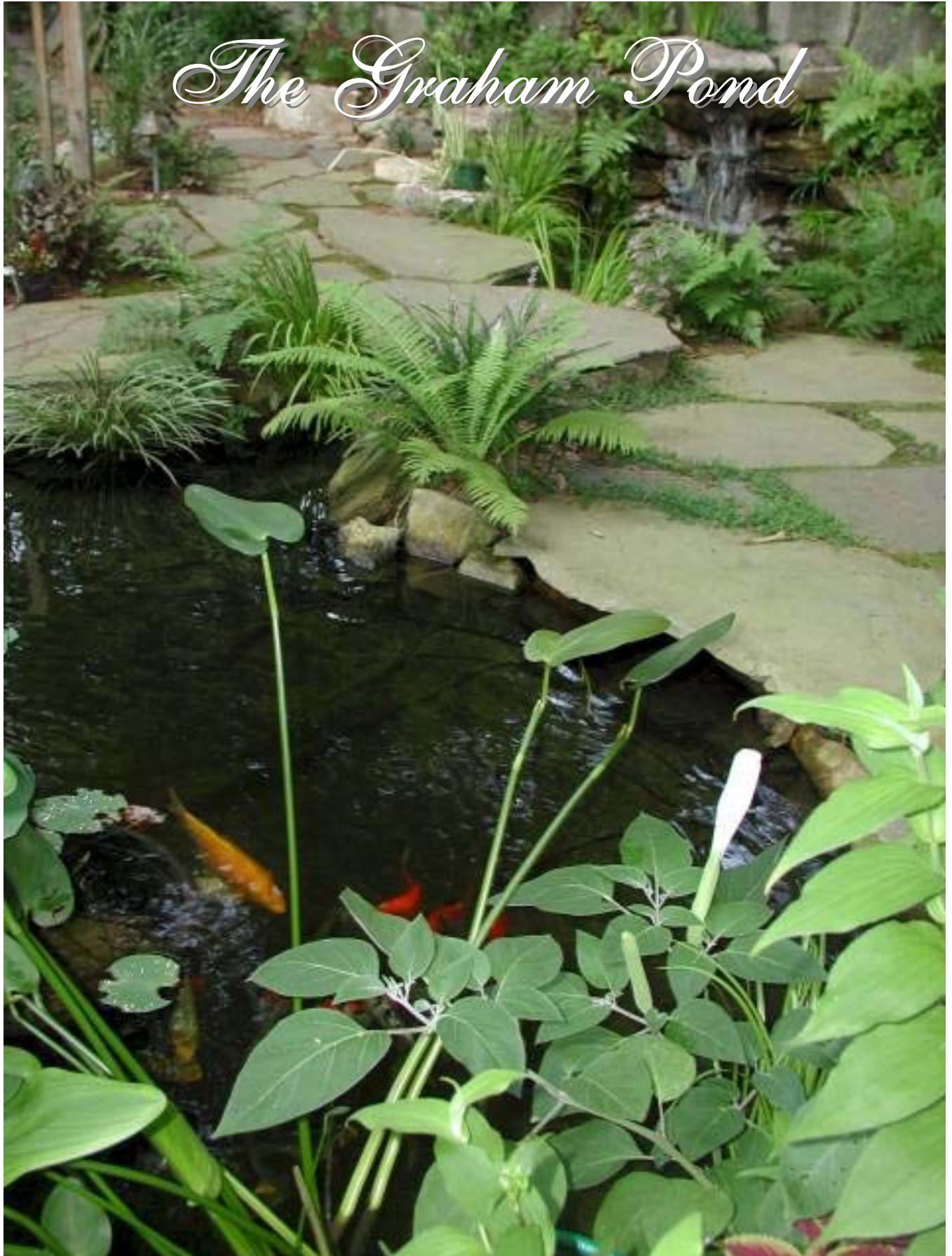


*The Graham Pond*





With help from his friend, Craig Bjurstrom, Alan designed and installed this 2800-gallon combination koi pond and water garden. It could have been a professional installation. All state-of-the-art, Alan held back nothing to insure an enjoyable, low-maintenance ponding experience.

Comfy and cozy come to mind when describing Alan's shady pond environment. He confesses that he's fallen asleep by the pond — but who wouldn't? The pond consists of 3 pools. Water spills from rocks into the first pool then travels via stream to the largest pool that houses most of the fish, the largest koi being "Jethro" so named for his size and shameless personality. The water drops 5 ft. down from the upper pond into the pool at the base of the stairs. The waterfall is graced by several flowering plants, caladiums and euphorbia. The flagstone patio is lit at night by low-voltage copper down-lights and the waterfalls are backlit which makes this pond enchanting at night.



2 bottom drains feed 2 external pumps. A ProBead 2.65 biofilter keeps the water clean while an 80-watt Emperor UV keeps the water clear.
